Emerging Disciples Group Forming

Emerging Disciples is a life changing discipleship and spiritual formation process for adult believers. This set of experiences and relationships will guide you into a personal exploration of three primary questions in your life: Who is God? Who am I? What does God desire to do through me?

An Emerging Disciple group (6-12 people who include men, women, young, old, experienced leaders and those just beginning to explore their potential) will be facilitated by Mike Shelley. Participants will meet together in weekly, 2-hour small group meetings, guided by Mike, that encourage accountable, safe relationships, thoughtful reflection, honest conversation and prayer. Group members spend 2-4 hours each week reading and prayerfully reflecting on the content presented in the manual, a book of the Bible, and the recommended text for each stage.

Emerging Disciples informational sessions will be held in Fellowship Hall A on Sunday, August 22, at 9:00am and 5:00pm.
